

A HANDY CHECKLIST FOR YOUR ANNUAL CHECK UP!

Don't know what to ask your veterinarian? One of the most important ways to help keep your feline friend healthy and happy is an annual veterinary examination. This checklist can help remind you what to ask your veterinarian to get the most from your visits.

Kitten 0-12 Months

1. If my cat will be indoors, do I need to spay or neuter?
2. When should I get my kitten spayed or neutered?
3. Should my kitten be microchipped?
4. How can I get my kitten comfortable with the car? With his carrier? With tooth brushing?
5. Is there an optimal vaccine schedule?
6. What should I know about setting up his litter box?
7. Should I get a scratching post or toys?

Junior 13months to 2 Years

1. My cat is an indoor cats, do I need vaccinations?
2. How much should my cat weigh?
3. How can I keep my cat's teeth clean?
4. How can I keep my cat active?
5. Do I need to change my cat's diet?

Adult 3-6 Years

1. Does my cat need a dental cleaning?
2. How much should my cat weigh?
3. How much activity does my cat need?

Mature 7-10 Years

1. How much should my cat weigh?
2. How much activity does my cat need?
3. Does my cat's diet need changing?
4. What physical and behavioural changes should I watch for?
5. What is the best way to deal with fleas, ticks and other parasites?
6. Does my cat need any special blood tests or urinalysis?
7. When should I bring my cat back for its next check up?

Senior 11+ Years

1. Should I change or supplement my cat's diet?
2. What physical or behavioural changes should I be looking for?
3. Do I need to modify my litter box?
4. What is the best way to deal with fleas, ticks and other parasites?
5. Does my cat need any special blood tests or urinalysis?
6. When should I bring my cat back for its next check up?
